

Western NC Support



Susan and I represented Mt Pleasant Christian Church to Spruce Pine, NC in the western part that was devastated by Hurricane Helene. We helped deliver 1000 sq ft of flooring to Beaver Creek Baptist Church there. The Pastor, Brandon Pittman was there. He was very appreciative of the assistance and wants to send his and the Church's loving thanks for the support and help. The Church is beautiful and the main part, the sanctuary, was above the flooding but the classrooms below were flooded and the floors had to be ripped out and restored. Part of our Church's Harvest Sale money, \$2.2K out of the \$5K that we directed to Western NC (WNC) Churches, went to the flooring in these classrooms so they can resume Sunday School classes. This is a blessed example of Church helping Church. Our Church was blessed to be able to donate \$5K to Churches, \$5K for a Tiny Home for people and \$5K to the Baptist Men's Association, all for WNC support. Danny and Angel Marks have been there over 4 weeks, off and on and got us in touch with the Pastor. Brandon is a very good man of God and has been helping other Churches in restoration and remaining active. Again, the damage there is unbelievable. Please keep these people in your Prayers. 






CHURCH MISSIONS 28394 BY: EARL WILLIAMS

Our church has a mission fund, Mission 28394, which is a designated fund. This means that the fund is not supported by the church budget but the fund is only supported by individuals putting in money and designating it for the Mission 28394, by check, noting for Mission 28394 on the check or putting cash in an envelope and designating it for Mission 28394 on the envelope. This fund is for the Church members and the community. We have helped people in the church and people not in the Church but with needs in the community. We recently helped build a ramp for Judy McPherson, who was in a bad car accident, had a severely injured leg, went through rehab but needed a ramp when she came home. We have attached pictures of the ramp and the designated funds to Mission 28394 paid for the lumber and materials to build the ramp. We try to do a project each quarter and with the generous donations from our Church, we have helped several people with ramps or repairs needed. We did a ramp for Josephine and Bill Paulus, when Bill lost his leg earlier and a back door ramp. Bill and lo donated money to the fund to pay for the lumber. Our church is so blessed to be able to do these projects for needy individuals that it is a blessing for our whole church..




Mission 28394: Mt Pleasant Christian Church

Mission 28394 is a mission-oriented function of Mt Pleasant Christian Church (MPCC) to support members of the Church and the community that need assistance or help for financial issues that may arise. The fund is tracked by our Financial Team but is not a budgeted item. Which means the money is not budgeted from the general offerings but only gets money if individuals designate a portion of their offering to the mission fund. All offerings go into the General Fund unless designated for a particular item, such as the Mission Fund. The Deacons Benevolent Fund is a budgeted fund that is administrated by the Deacons to provide help in times of need. The Benevolent Fund can only assist a person/family once per year. This is a separate function and is not tied into Mission 28394.

Mission 28394 is managed by members of the Church that want to be involved in helping families and we do a project each quarter. We are not as limited as the Benevolent Fund but still can only assist one person/family once per year. Supported projects are emailed to the participating members and if a majority approves the project, then we do it.

Our 4th Quarter 2024 Project was to get the lumber for a ramp for a member of the community that has been very active. She helped each week on Wednesday in our Cameron Hill Outreach Mission and is always volunteering for service. She has family members who are members of our Church. She assisted at the Moore County Fairgrounds working on the Tiny Houses for the Western NC projects. She was in an auto accident which injured her ankle severely and forced her into a wheelchair. Her home had no ramp, so Mission 28394 coordinated with Builders First Source for the lumber and material to construct the ramp. Danny Marks and some of his family and several members of our Church, took a day to complete the 22 ft ramp for her to manage to get in and out of the house. This is the kind of help we provide to our Church and community to have God's love show through our actions. Thanks to everyone that participates in Mission 28394 and especially those that designate funds each Sunday to support our efforts. We have added some pictures of the ramp. God Bless.
